The Guelph/Wellington Community Health Van is a Mobile Outreach Health and Harm Reduction Service. The van makes stops in Guelph and Rural Wellington providing **harm reduction supplies, food & hygiene products, first aid supplies, clothing & camping gear.**

We have our **peer support worker** for informal/formal support, counselling and debriefing. Additionally, our **nurse and a social support worker** can provide wound care, blood testing and treatment, referrals and system navigation.
