# PARAFLUOROFENTANYL?

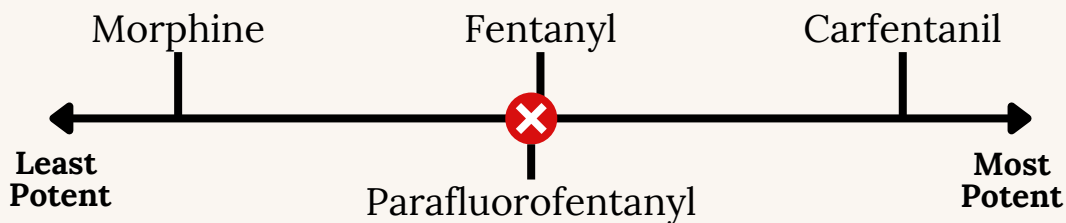
“pa-ruh-fluor-oh-FEN-tuh-nahl”

aka. “p-fluorofentanyl”, “4-fluorofentanyl”, “pFF”

Parafluorofentanyl is a **fentanyl analog** and an **opioid analgesic**.

While it can be detected by fentanyl test strips, parafluorofentanyl **cannot** be detected by regular toxicology screens and **requires special toxicology testing**.

## Dangers of Parafluorofentanyl



Parafluorofentanyl is **commonly cut into other drugs**. It has frequently been found in **heroin packets**, but has been detected in a variety of other drugs and counterfeit pills. The most common form of administration is **injection**.

Parafluorofentanyl can **increase the chance of overdose when combined with other opioids**.
